

Provide the public, legal professionals, and students with legal resources and the highest quality of service in order to provide access to justice and information.



The Sonoma County Public Law Library

is a state government agency separate from the county government. The Law Library is funded primarily by court filing fees and governed by an independent Board of Trustees, consisting of five judges and two lay people. The Library maintains a quiet environment in which patrons may conduct legal research. Giving legal advice is beyond the scope of our service. The staff can help you navigate through the available books, databases, organizations, and appropriate programs and services.


COLLECTION

Our collection has over 30,000 books, CDs, and other material, and it is offered to you without any charge. There are updated federal and state codes, statutes and regulations, as well as a large number of secondary sources including treatises, law reviews, encyclopedias, ALR annotations, Restatements, dictionaries, and legal newspapers. Guidebooks from CEB, Matthew Bender, Thompson Reuters, Rutter Group, James, and many other publishers are available for the public. We provide, also without any charge, online legal databases such as Westlaw and Advance LexisNexis. You can Shepardize your authorities through books or through LexisNexis, which is the easiest and most common way. The Library also provides MCLE Self-Study materials.



MEETING ROOM RENTALS

Two conference rooms are available for rent at the Law Library for depositions, mediations, client meetings, or trial preparation. Rent starts at \$25 per hour. A projection screen for classes and seminars is available in the large meeting room, which can hold up to 25 people comfortably.



We are located by the Superior Court of Sonoma with free parking and easy access to and from Highway 101. There is free Wi-Fi, and all our computers are connected to the internet. You can also print from any computer and copy, scan, and fax documents.

PASSPORT SERVICES



The Law Library is an official Passport Acceptance Facility. With this status we offer the convenience of scheduling an appointment to apply for and/or renew your passport without the hassle of going someplace with lines and expensive parking.
